What we can see depends on the time of the night and time of the year.

We plan to show you objects from the following list.

The number of things we see depends on how clear the sky is and how bright the Moon is.

Galaxies are not visible if the Moon is visible during the session.

The visibility of Nebulae & Globular Clusters are impacted if the Moon is visible in the sky during the session, and not visible on the days around Full Moon.
